Dear Students and Parents,

Welcome to seventh grade and to the Knights team at Mountain View Middle School. We are looking forward to a successful year. As a student attending Mountain View Middle School, you are expected to live up to and maintain certain standards such as having **integrity**, working **diligently**, and creating a **pleasant atmosphere** for others around you.

Cumberland Valley has a **One to One** policy this year. Students must bring their district issued device to class every day. This includes the charger for their device. In the classroom, students may only use the devices when they are part of the teacher's instruction. The CVSD discipline procedures will be utilized when students do not follow the stated policies. **This year cell phones will not be allowed during the school day and must be powered off and put away.** This is new and will be enforced schoolwide.

Students will be assigned a locker this year, although we will still permit them to carry backpacks. Water bottles (with lid) are also still encouraged. Students may only have water in water bottles at school. As in previous years, there is no gum allowed in school. Please ensure that your student does not come to school with gum.

Interims will be posted mid-marking period but please check Schoology for more regular grade and assignment updates. Parents should check Schoology frequently for updated grades. Please discuss these grades with your child regularly. If you have any questions regarding your child's grade that he/she cannot answer, feel free to contact the teacher directly. Also Helpful: (not required, but may prove useful)

- An age appropriate student dictionary, thesaurus, atlas and almanac
- Folders for reports and notebook collections

The agenda notebooks will be available to any students who request them. This assignment book should go home every night so parents can monitor assignments and test/quiz dates.
