Required* Materials

So that you are prepared for the school year, here is a list of materials we would like students to have for our team this year.

- (1) 2” 3-ring binder (will hold folders for all team courses)
- 5 two pocket folders that are 3 hole punched (one for each team subject and can be stored in the 3-ring binder)
- 1 spiral-bound notebooks for math class
- Graphing paper for math class – can be in a spiral bound notebook
- TI-30 Calculator
- Pencils (regular #2), erasers
- Corded earbuds (compatible with Chromebooks) New this year- students will NOT be permitted to have Air Pods or Bluetooth earbuds
- Pencil pouch (suggested, not required)
- A set of colored pencils (suggested, not required)
- Highlighters (suggested, not required)
- Water bottle - students are encouraged to bring a water bottle with a lid (not a straw.) Students may only have water in the bottle.

Other items to note:

- **Assignment book (agenda)** - The school will supply an assignment book to each student on the first day of school.
- **Lockers/backpacks**- students will be assigned a locker this year and they will be able to carry around a backpack.

- **Cell phones** – New at Mountain View this year – cell phones must be off and away for the entire day. Students will not be permitted to use their cell phones in school.
