6CYCLONE PARENT CHEAT SHEET

Transitioning to middle school life can be just as stressful for parents as it is for the students. We're here to help make it easy!

Here are a couple of pointers to help you adjust:

- 1. When your child is **absent**, it's best to encourage them to check the Schoology agendas to see what they missed. They should also check in with their teachers when they return because not only did they miss the homework, they missed what occurred in class that day as well. **FLEX, SOAR, and homeroom are great times to check in with teachers!!** Students are allowed one day to make up their work for every day they are absent.
- 2. **Schoology**? What is this "Schoology" thing? Each student has a Schoology account. Your student's user id and password is the same as the id and password they use to log into their school laptop. Schoology is an excellent tool that links the students to their subject classes, homework calendar, class updates, grades, etc. Schoology is best accessed via the CVSD website under the student tab at the top of the page.
- 3. **TEAM concerns**? If you have a concern the entire team should know about, feel free to email Mr. Graybill (team leader: mgraybill@cvschools.org). If you have a concern about a specific class, please email that teacher directly.

- 4. **Middle school Grades** Please check your child's grades regularly to monitor their progress. The biggest transition from elementary to middle school is realizing that we are no longer using Mastery Connect. Every assignment affects the student's overall grade. In order to make honor roll, students need to maintain an average of 90% or above. In order to pass a course, students must maintain a 70% or above.
- 5. **Laptops** Laptops are to be used for educational purposes only. Students who do not follow this guideline may find their access to their laptop restricted.
